And remember, I am with you always, to the end of the age."

The meeting was called to order by President Les Hengeveld with 9 members present and Pastor Mark.

The pastor opened with devotions.

Secretary's Report: MSC to approve the secretary's report.

Treasurer's Report: MSC to approve the treasurer's report. Treasurer suggested the Trustees take inventory of church effects and belongings (ie: organ, pews, etc.) to determine if replacement insurance on such would be warranted. This could take several months and, if desired, would be activated in 2025.

Parsonage Report: MSC to approve the parsonage report. Balance is \$10,457.11. The current renters have agreed to stay despite the increase in rent and pet deposits..

Pastor's Report: First will offer First Communion classes to anyone interested. Please provide names of those interested to the Pastor.

Old Business:

A plumber has checked the problem in the men's bathroom. The on demand water heater is the cause of the smell. That type of water heater needs regular maintenance whether it is used or not. MSC to replace the current water heater with a standard 10 gallon water heater for around \$939 plus tax. The money will come from the Memorial Fund.

The stove found at Dow Rummel is not yet ready to move to First. We will wait for it.

Loads of Love event was a success! Approximately 12 volunteers helped with preparing, serving and miscellaneous duties at the event. We served around 120 people, and gave away the leftover food. We agreed to do this again. For future events, to go boxes, zip loc bags and extra water would be helpful. Don has to go boxes available for our use.

New Business:

The annual meeting is Sunday, January 21. The ballot is filled for the election of church council members.

Art is planning to start the organ renewal in March and hopes to be done by Easter Sunday, March 31.

Next Council meeting is February 20, 2024.
