The season of Lent is not specifically mentioned in the Bible, it is a season began by the church many years ago, but I cannot give you a specific time or place.

Neela Kale is a writer and catechetical minister based in the Archdiocese of Portland, and she has written a short article about Lent I would like to share with you: "Lent, the period of 40 days that precedes the celebration of Easter, has its origin in the early days of the Church. Converts seeking to become Christian, who at that time were mostly adults, spent several years in study and preparation. Under the threat of Roman persecution, becoming a Christian was serious business, so their process of preparation was intensive! Then they went through a final period of "purification and enlightenment" for the 40 days before their baptism at Easter. The rest of the Church began to observe the season of Lent in solidarity with these newest Christians. It became an opportunity for all Christians to recall and renew the commitment of their baptism.

Today we know Lent as a season of conversion: We acknowledge the ways we have turned away from God in our lives, and We focus on turning our hearts and minds back toward God. Hence the three pillars of Lent are prayer, fasting, and almsgiving. These observances help us turn away from whatever has distracted or derailed us and to turn back to God. Giving up something for Lent is ultimately a form of fasting. We can deprive ourselves of some small pleasure or indulgence and offer that sacrifice up to God. Or we might "give up" a bad habit such as smoking as a way of positively turning our life back toward what God wants for us."

Lent means many things to many people and even if you don't "give up" something for Lent, it should still be a time of reflection and refocusing, and as Ms, Kale states, it can be a period of "purification and enlightenment" as well as a time when we contemplate our sin, both "the things we have done, and the things we have left undone".

As we make this journey together through the purification and enlightenment of Lent, we should all contemplate the things in our lives that pull us away from God. Things like strained or broken relationships or forgiveness that needs to be both given and received with grace.

These all can be difficult things to do because none of us wants to admit that we are in the wrong, and strained or broken relationships can have a detrimental affect on us physically as well as emotionally.

So, during this Lenten season, I encourage us all to a time of self-reflection of our lives of faith and do what we can, with God's help, to eliminate those things that strain our relationship with each other and with God.

Sin is more than doing something wrong, sin separates us from one another, and it also separates us from God. However, unlike humanity, God is always more willing to forgive than we are to ask for forgiveness.

So, as we journey through Lent, may we all graciously give and receive forgiveness from one another and may we find peace and joy in our time of self-reflection and contemplation and renewed relationships.
