This is the greeting we use on Easter Sunday to announce the Good News that death did not and could not hold Jesus in the tomb. **CHRIST HAS RISEN!!!** 

When the women went to the tomb that first Easter morning, they had expectations about what they would see and what they needed to do. Even though they witnessed the brutal and agonizing treatment of their teacher and friend, they knew what they needed to do. Even though Jesus was gone, still they wanted to serve him in a way that others probably would not have done. They went to do for him what the law and tradition required.

But when they arrived their expectations were not met. Instead they encountered an empty tomb in the place where they expected an occupied tomb.

A life of faith is like that, sometimes. Our expectations of what God is doing in our lives is radically changed and if often catches us off guard. We know what we want, but God has other things in mind for us, and God's plan is always the better one.

This Easter season, as we experience the empty tomb, I pray that our expectations of what God is doing in our lives is changed so dramatically, that, like the women that first Easter, we are perplexed. So much so that we come to realize just what the resurrection means for us.

Jesus resurrection means that, just as death could not hold Jesus in the tomb, we too are now free from the power of sin and death and we can say, with boldness, "CHRIST HAS RISEN...HE HAS RISEN INDEED...ALLELUIA!!!

May the risen Lord bring us new and exciting expectations and the joy that only the resurrection can bring.

May the peace of God, which passes all understanding, keep our hearts and minds in Christ Jesus our Lord. AMEN.


#### JOINT WORSHIP SERVICES for the summer months will start on Sunday, May 28th, with the service held at Palisade Lutheran.
